



SIMPLIFIED SCORE SHEET INSTRUCTIONS

Before the Match

After the coin toss, record the following information:

- Team names on the correct sides for sets 1 and 2 – teams will not switch sides
- “X’s” for serve / receive for sets 1 and 2
- The First Referee (LAST NAME, FIRST NAME)

When you receive the team lineup sheets, record the following information

- Captains
- Liberos
- Lineups

During the Match

- Record each point as signaled by the first referee by slashing the number in the Running Score.
- Record substitutions by entering the new player in the box next to the player they are replacing and then slash the next number in the Substitution counter at the bottom.
 - If it appears you will run out of boxes, you can divide the boxes.
- If the Libero serves, draw a triangle around the Roman numeral of the player for whom the Libero served.
 - The Libero may only serve in one rotation, so there should never be more than one triangle for each team in the same set.
- When a team calls a time out, record the current score with the score of the team calling the time out listed first.
- At the end of each set, circle the last point scored for each team in the Running Score columns and enter team names and scores in the Set Results area.

After the Match

- Ensure the correct teams are recorded as winning and losing each set and that the points scored match the points in the Running Score.
- Record the Match Winner and the number of sets won by each team (2:0, 2:1, or 3:0).
- Ask the First Referee to initial after verifying that all of the results information is correct.
